

PERFORMANCE ENROLMENT FOR 2025

Performance lessons occur during school hours up to 3:20pm. Each lesson is 30 minutes in length. Students are expected to catch up on any work they miss by being out of class, and to give plenty of notice if they cannot leave class due to an assessment.

Fees are charged each term and reflect the current private market rates (Generally between \$30-\$45 per half hour lesson). Some instrument lessons are covered by the itinerant music scheme and are of no cost to the student. These spaces are limited and NCEA students are given preference.
